MAIN OUTLINE OF THE POSITION	The primary purpose of this position is to facilitate our Arts Bus program, which was successfully trialled in 2019. The Program Manager would drive the Arts Bus to pre-arranged locations around city and country Victoria, offering activities to children experiencing hardship in the 5-15 year age group. The Program Manager would, in collaboration with AKC members, develop, manage and lead the Arts Bus program. The Program Manager would then be responsible for the day-to-day running of the Bus and implementing its program; managing and co-ordinating logistics and the calendar. The successful applicant would provide other duties, as specified by Artists for Kids Culture.
Key RESPONSIBILITIES	The Program Manager would be responsible for delivering the Arts Bus program and managing the relationship between councils, youth service providers and children; reporting on goals, milestones and budgets on a regular basis. They would also, in collaboration with key AKC members, develop a program that ensures that we offer high quality activities that meet the needs of the target audience (5-15 years).
